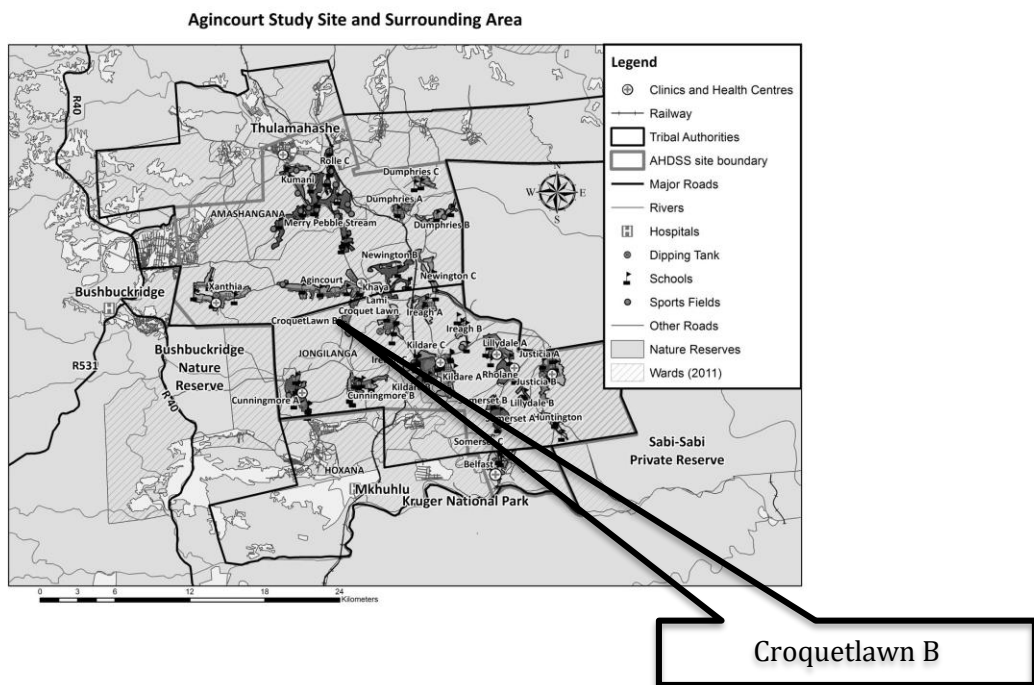


CROQUETLAWN B VILLAGE FACT SHEET 2016

This “Fact Sheet” provides basic information on population changes and demographics for Croquetlawn B village. Whenever you use this information, please reference it as being obtained from MRC/Wits Rural Public Health and Health Transitions Research Unit (Agincourt).

Village Growth and Population over the Period 1994 - 2015

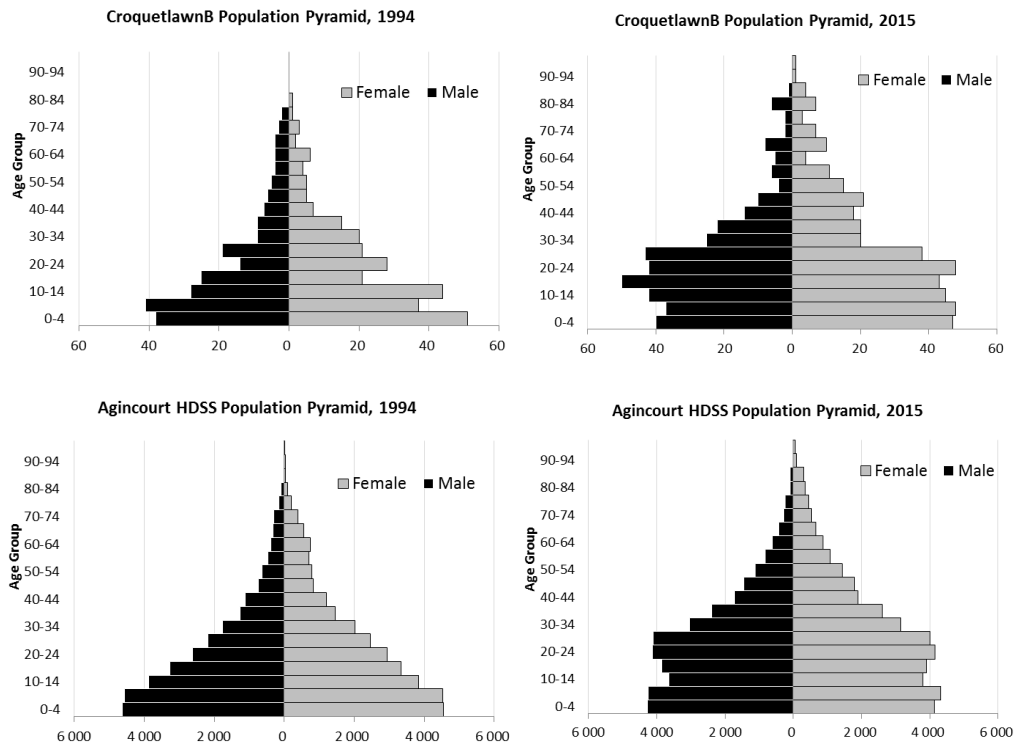
The numbers shown below are calculated according to numbers for the end of June 2015. The numbers are known as mid-year population figures.

You can compare the population structure between Croquetlawn B village and the Agincourt HDSS research site (1994 and 2015) by looking at the population pyramids below.



Take home message: The number of households in Croquetlawn B village has increased since 1994. The population has also grown between the years of 1994 and 2015. The population structure of Croquetlawn B village strongly follows the structure of the Agincourt HDSS research site.



Births

Number of Births by Gender

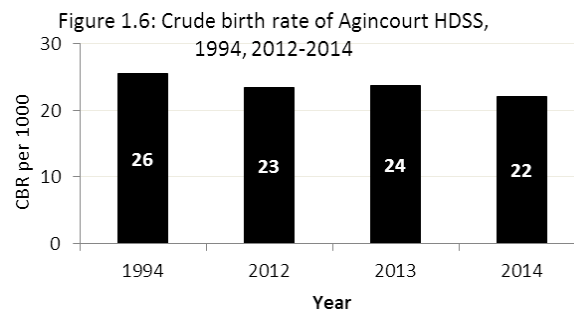
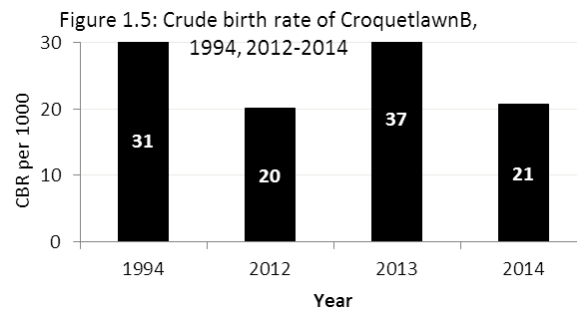
The number of births recorded in Croquetlawn B village is shown below. We can only provide data to the end of 2014. We compared the birth trends in Croquetlawn B village with the rest of the Agincourt HDSS research site below.

Births by Gender in Croquetlawn B Village, 1994 and 2014

The numbers of births show an upward trend in Croquetlawn B village. In 2014 there was an increase in the number of births.

Crude Birth Rate (how many babies born for every one thousand people)

We can show the crude birth rate in Croquetlawn B village from 1994 to 2014. We show the crude birth rates in the Agincourt HDSS research site from 1994 to 2014.



The crude birth rate is found by comparing the number of babies born to the total population. For example, in graph above, for every 1000 people living in Croquetlawn B village in the year 2014, 21 babies were born.

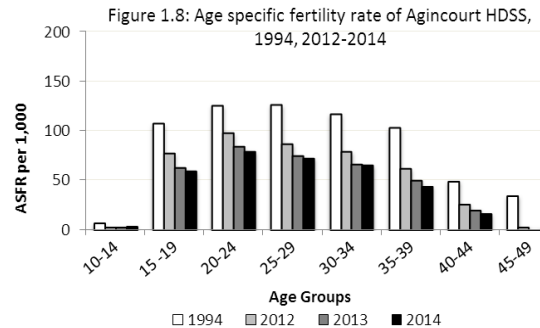
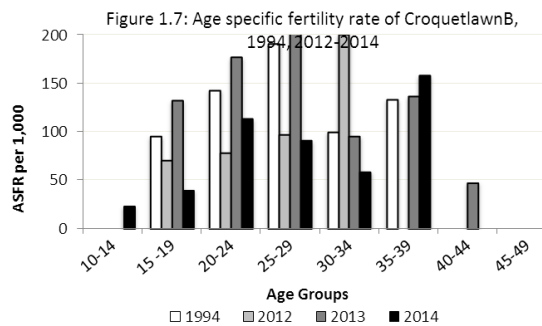
When you compare the crude birth rates in Croquetlawn B village with the crude birth rate for the whole of the Agincourt HDSS research site, they are relatively similar. One difference is that Croquetlawn B had a decrease in births in 2014 and Agincourt HDSS did not.

Births by Mother's Age and Age Specific Fertility Rates

Research within the Agincourt HDSS research site continues to look closely at fertility. Below we show you the number of babies born to mothers of different ages in Croquetlawn B village.

We can also look at trends across the whole site and compare them with Croquetlawn B village below.



We find the age specific fertility rate by looking at how many women in a certain age group have had babies in a certain year. For example, if we look at the graph above, we can see that in the year 2014 in Croquetlawn B village, for every 1000 women ages 15-19, about 40 of them gave birth.

Take home message: 2014 saw significant decreases in fertility throughout all age groups except 10-14, 35-39, and 45-49.

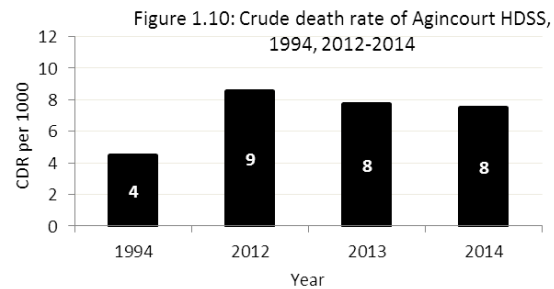
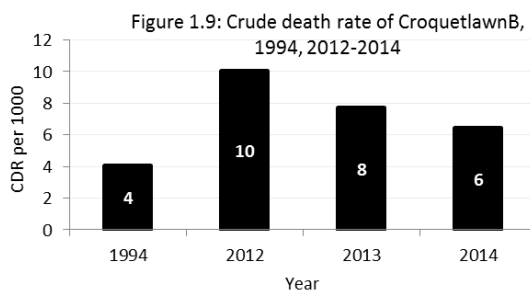
Deaths

Deaths

The MRC/Wits Agincourt Unit only gives *numbers* of deaths for each age group in each village, not the *cause* of death. The number of deaths occurring is low and if the cause of death is given, then a person's confidentiality may be broken. Below we show you the total number of deaths that occurred in Croquetlawn B village in 1994 and in 2014.

Below you can compare the crude death rates over the same period in Croquetlawn B village and across the Agincourt HDSS research site.



The crude death rate is found by looking at how many people died for every 1000 people living in the population. For example, in 2014, for every 1000 people in the population of Croquetlawn B village, 6 died.

The data shows that the crude death rate has increased greatly from the levels seen in 1994, across the whole population of the Agincourt HDSS research site. However, there is a suggestion that the death rate may be falling. We need to carry on watching these figures to see if this is really a trend. We are beginning to think that there really is a downward trend in death rates, probably because of the increase in ARVs for people with HIV.

MIGRATION

Permanent migration patterns

The table below has the numbers of how many people have moved in to Croquetlawn B village permanently and out of Croquetlawn B village permanently.

Take home message: The number of people permanently moving in and out of Croquetlawn B village is decreasing. It is important to understand how many people are moving in and out of the village.
