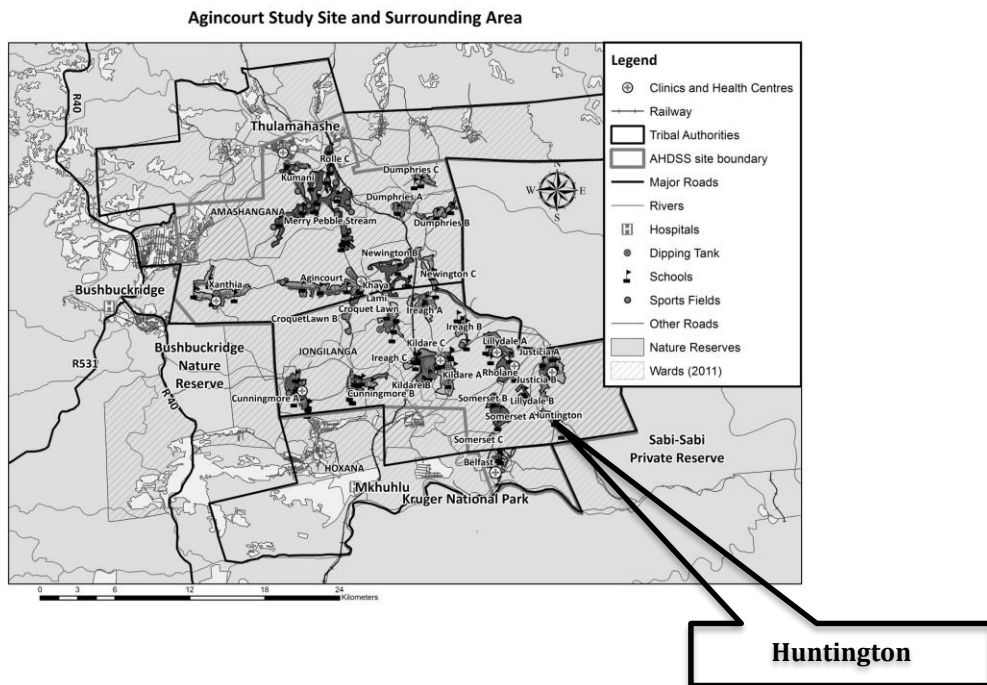


HUNTINGTON VILLAGE FACT SHEET 2016

This “Fact Sheet” provides basic information on population changes and demographics for Huntington village. Whenever you use this information, please reference it as being obtained from MRC/Wits Rural Public Health and Health Transitions Research Unit (Agincourt).

The numbers shown below are calculated according to numbers for the end of June 2015. The numbers are known as mid-year population figures.

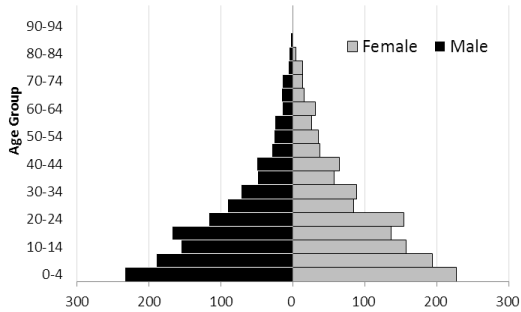

Below you can see how many people were living in Huntington village of different ages in June 2015.

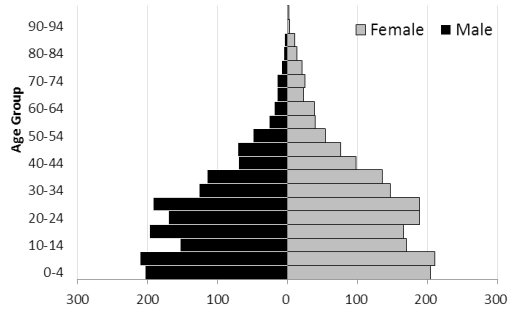

You can compare the population structure between Huntington village and the Agincourt HDSS research site (1994 and 2015) by looking at the population pyramids below.

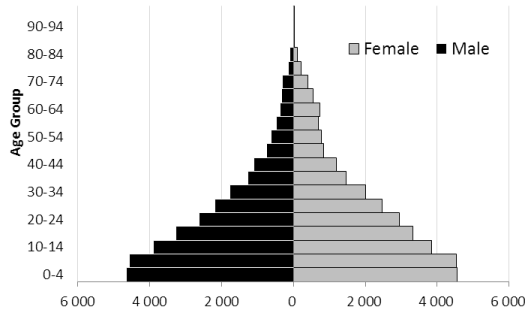
Huntington Population Pyramid, 1994



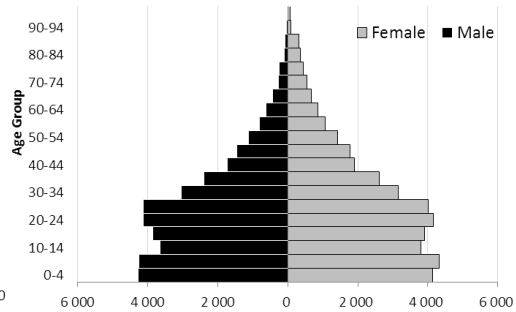
Huntington Population Pyramid, 2015

Take home message: The number of households in Huntington village has increased since 1994. The population has also grown between the years of 1994 and 2015. The population structure of Huntington village strongly follows the structure of the Agincourt HDSS research site.

Births

Number of Births by Gender

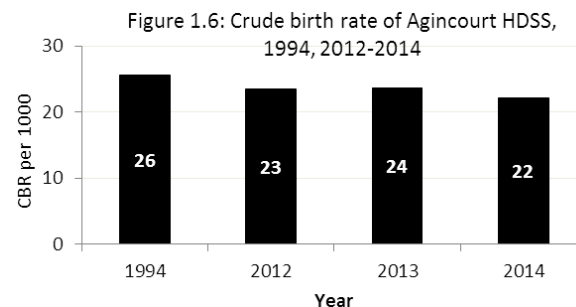
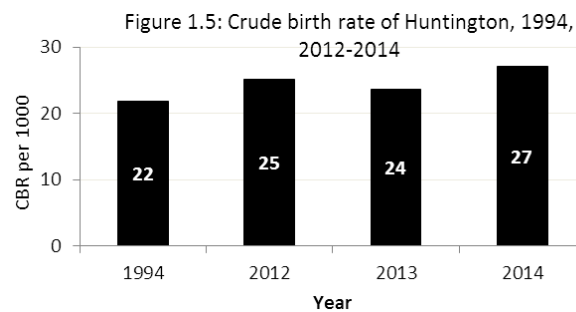
The number of births recorded in Huntington village is shown below. We can only provide data to the end of 2014.

Births by Gender in Huntington Village, 1994 and 2014

The numbers of births show an upward trend in Huntington village. In 2014 there was an increase in the number of births.

Crude Birth Rate (how many babies born for every one thousand people)

We compared the birth trends in Huntington village with the rest of the Agincourt HDSS research site in the graphs below.



The crude birth rate is found by comparing the number of babies born to the total population. For example, above, for every 1000 people living in Huntington village in the year 2014, 27 babies were born.

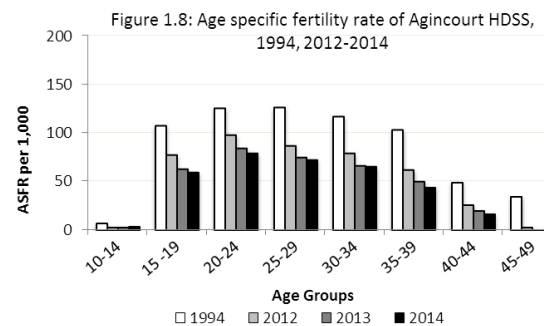
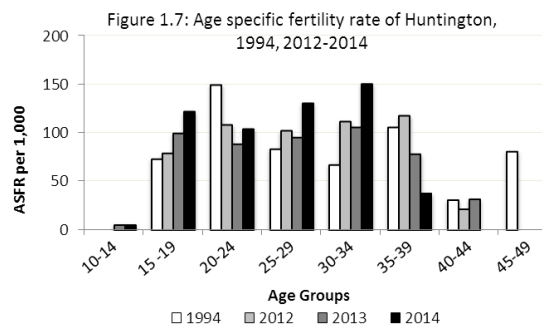
When you compare the crude birth rates in Huntington village with the crude birth rate for the whole of the Agincourt HDSS research site, they are relatively similar. One difference is that Huntington had an increase in births in 2014 and Agincourt HDSS had a decrease.

Births by Mother's Age and Age Specific Fertility Rates

Research within the Agincourt HDSS research site continues to look closely at fertility. You can see the number of babies born to mothers of different ages in Huntington village below.

We can also look at trends across the whole site and compare them with Huntington village.



We find the age specific fertility rate by looking at how many women in a certain age group have had babies in a certain year. For example, we can see that in the year 2014 in Huntington village, for every 1000 women ages 15-19, about 120 of them gave birth.

Take home message: 2014 saw significant increases in fertility throughout ages 15-34, and decreases in ages 35-49.

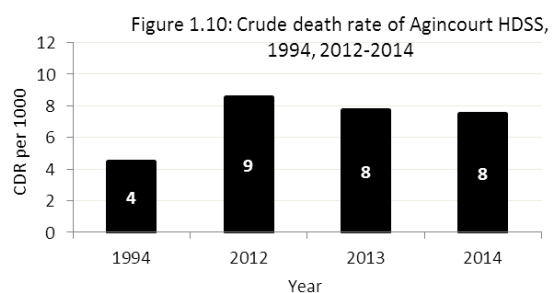
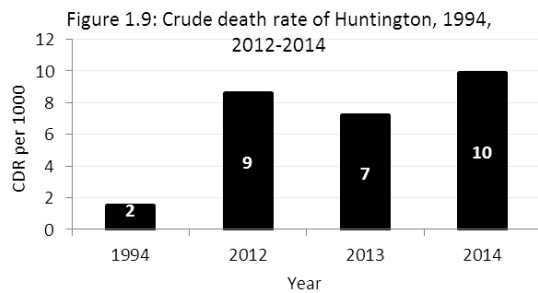
Deaths

Deaths

The MRC/Wits Agincourt Unit only gives *numbers* of deaths for each age group in each village, not the *cause* of death. The number of deaths occurring is low and if the cause of death is given, then a person's confidentiality may be broken. Below you can see the total number of deaths that occurred in Huntington village in 1994 and in 2014.

Below you can compare the crude death rates over the same period in Huntington village and across the Agincourt HDSS research site.



The crude death rate is found by looking at how many people died for every 1000 people living in the population. For example, in 2014, for every 1000 people in the population of Huntington village, 10 died.

The data shows that the crude death rate has increased greatly from the levels seen in 1994, across the whole population of the Agincourt HDSS research site. However, there is a suggestion that the death rate may be falling. We need to carry on watching these figures to see if this is really a trend. We are beginning to think that there really is a downward trend in death rates, probably because of the increase in ARVs for people with HIV.

MIGRATION

Permanent migration patterns

Below you can see how many people have moved in to and out of Huntington village permanently.

Take home message: The number of people permanently moving into Huntington village is increasing, but the number of people moving out is decreasing. It is important to understand how many people are moving in and out of the village.
